## Billy cart specifications

- Under 40kg weight (Scallywags and Open)
- Up to 70 kg for Competition class
- Wheel-base maximum 2.1m with maximum overhang 300mm
- Minimum width 800mm
- Steering is to be either wheel or rope
- No propulsion devices; Must have working brakes
- All wheel spokes must be enclosed; no dangerous protrusions

### **Entry conditions**

- The organisers are Cawdor Public School and Cawdor Rural Fire Service.
- The race is to be held on Old Razorback Road and Cawdor Road; each competitor will have a minimum of two races.
- Tracks are 100m (Scallywags) and 200m free roll.
