Dear Parents and Friends of Cawdor PS



24 Hr Fight Against Cancer Macarthur

Silver medallist Paralympian, Mr Paul Nunnari, visited Cawdor PS on Friday morning at the start of his annual wheelchair push to raise money for the 24 Hr Fight Against Cancer, Macarthur.


The students in K-2 met Paul and his roadcrew and Andrew Hayes, our Yr 2 Student Councillor, presented Paul with a \$200 donation from Cawdor PS.

The 24 Fight Against Cancer Macarthur has raised more than \$3.5 million in just eleven years for the Macarthur Cancer Therapy Centre, the Paediatric Ambulatory Care Unit, the Oncology Ward at Campbelltown Hospital and the Palliative Care Unit and outreach services at Camden Hospital. Each year they target donations provided by the schools involved in the Wheelchair Push for support of children with cancer receiving treatment in our local area. Just recently they have provided iPads and iTunes vouchers for their use during chemotherapy treatments, murals for the walls, multi-coloured treatment trolleys and visits by two pet therapy dogs, Shadow and Demon which are always well received by the children and their parents.

Please come along if you are able to help out after 1.00 pm on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday this week.






