FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK:

Dear Parents and Friends of Cawdor PS

With the Billy Cart Derby on next Sunday, the final countdown is on. To ensure its success, we need the support of all of our families. Please consider volunteering on the day or at the working bee on the Saturday afternoon.

Unfortunately our supply of hay bales for the Billy Cart Derby fell through, and we have had to purchase 450 straw bales for the event. The bales will now be delivered at 6am on the morning of the derby so we will need many helpers to place the bales on the roadside to form a protective barrier for the track. We will also need utes and trailers to transport the bales at the end of the day to the school grounds. Thank you to the families who have already offered their assistance. To recoup the cost of the bales, we will be selling the bales at the end of the derby for \$10 each. The bales can be used as animal bedding or garden mulch. Please use the form in today's newsletter if you wish to pre-order straw bales. You will need to arrange your own transport of the bales.

At the working bee on Saturday we will need to clear the roadside to allow easy access for pedestrians so we will require whipper snippers and general gardening tools. Other jobs at the working bee will include painting the start and finish lines, displaying signs and posters, and levelling the entry to the carpark on the corner of Lagoon Flats Place and Cawdor Rd.

The Vella family have kindly donated vegetable seedlings for sale on the day. These will be sold at a school stall which will also sell second hand books and cakes. Books and cakes for the stall can be left at the office throughout the week or on Saturday afternoon (12.00—3.00) during the working bee. Cakes need to have a list of ingredients attached.

Many thanks to all of the families who have donated prizes for the raffle and to those who have sold raffle tickets. All tickets need to be back at school by Friday.

Colouring competition entries also need to be back at school by Friday.

A huge thank you to Mrs Greg Sitkowski who is working hard to modify the starting ramp for the races.


Current families are asked to inform friends, families and neighbours that enrolments are now open for next year.
