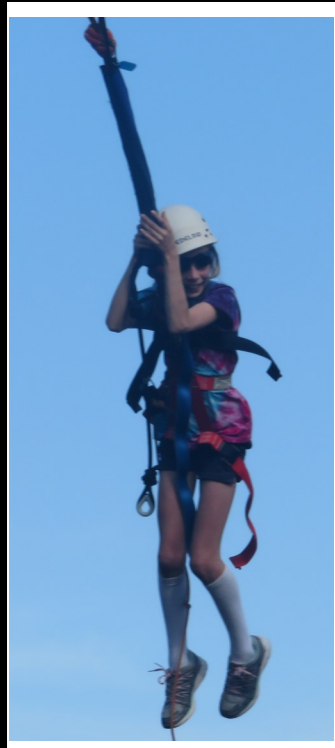

Dear Parents and Caregivers

Welcome back to Term 4 and what a huge term it is going to be. The Stage 3 students will be attending the postponed Jervis Bay Marine Camp excursion and Stage 2 will be attending Woogelmai camp and there will be a lot of other opportunities for the students' achievements to be celebrated.

I am appealing to parents and caregivers to help us out concerning the safety of our students in 2 major areas.

: we are unable to heat food up or add hot water to foods such as instant noodles. We have had many instances where children are bringing up their food to be heated. Small containers which retain heated food can be purchased at reasonable cost at Big W/KMart etc. It is a Work, Health and Safety ruling that we are unable to heat children's food.

: please exercise extreme caution when using the Church carpark. Mrs Hillier and I have witnessed some cars travelling in a manner which exceeds what is safe. We have had to put up extra star pickets so the children are kept safe due to some parents parking in front of the church door.

We have until the 25th October to complete the "Tell Them From Me" survey. Can I please ask families who have not completed it to do so by this date. It gives us valuable information and feedback and helps me to direct the school in a positive direction.

Cobbitty Village Market is a vibrant well-known country-style craft market that has been run by local community volunteers since May 1982. It provides **quality unique crafts and produce**, drawing large crowds of visitors from local and wider Sydney/NSW areas. As a non-profit organization, the market also functions as an important local fundraiser, typically raising \$40-50,000 each year that is distributed to local community groups, charities, and the disadvantaged.

The markets are held on **Cobbitty Public School grounds** on the **first Saturday of each month** except for January and February, and are **open to the public from 8am-1pm**. There are a large variety of stalls providing predominantly homemade art and craft, delicious foods and beverages to take home or eat at the market; some of which are provided by local groups including Lion's club, School P&C, and Scouts, for their own fund-raising. There is also entertainment, including local bands and groups. There is parking for 1,000 cars behind the school/along Cobbitty Road. **We warmly welcome** all visitors to our market, and encourage anyone **interested in joining our volunteer market committee** to contact us.
