Dear Parents and Friends of Cawdor PS

We welcome everyone back to Term 3 and we hope you had a fantastic holiday break. A warm welcome to our new students Maria (Year 4) and Christina (Year 3) and their family.

We are excited for students to be continuing their learning in all areas of the curriculum, athletics carnival and cricket gala days, education week and book week, bookfair and we can't forget our wonderful grand friend's day to finish the term.

Staff engaged in professional learning on Monday to give feedback on the Draft NSW Public Education plan and you will find information at the end of this newsletter on how as a school community member you can also provide feedback on this draft education plan. We also looked at a numeracy focus area of Number and Place Value and ways we can continue to support teaching and learning during Mathematics in line with new syllabus implementation. Staff engaged in professional learning on epilepsy to assist staff in care and management of students with this condition. The day also allowed for some planning and organisation for the term ahead.

I am pleased to advise we will be continuing extra curricula before and after school activities as an option for those wishing to register and funding received will continue to allow students to attend at no cost to families. The programs will commence in Week 2 and finish in Week 9. There will be no programs running in the last week of school this term. Please register before student places fill up as some activities have a capped limit. The providers are remaining the same as last term on the same days.

The school- based OT program will also be continuing for those students who were identified last term. We are beginning to see students transferring the skills they are learning each week into the classroom environment. School Attendance

We know that the last couple of years have been tough, and we will continue to prioritise student's health and wellbeing by listening to health advice, providing support and maintaining a safe learning environment.

We want to thank you for sending your children to school when they are well because our overall attendance rate for Semester 1 was a very high 91.4% and students attending school above 90% of the time was 63.9% which was well above the state rate. Let's see if we can further improve during Term 3.

Why attendance matters - Let's do the maths!

Missing a day here or there may not seem like much, but absences add up and can impact your child's learning more than you think.

When your child misses one day a week over a year, that's 40 days of school, 8 weeks of lessons and 2.5 years over their school life lost.
